ISSUES WITH SPEED

Good news!! They think they have found a technical breakthrough with the slow performance issue. They are testing it now.

KNOWN ISSUES THAT THEY ARE WORKING ON

- Displaying percentages in Parent Connect
- Gradebook reports are missing the <All Classes> option
- Student profile print does not print all assignments

ISSUES THAT HAVE BEEN FIXED

- Fixed how reports handle excused or excluded assignments
- Added <All Classes> as an option for printing student progress reports
- Added a sort by student option for student progress reports
- Removed tasks that are not counted as a grade from 'Missing Assignments'
- Added weighing information to progress reports when applicable

HELPFUL TIPS

- Don't use Internet Explorer7. If that is the version that is on your computer, try using Chrome or Firefox instead.
- To print seating charts, do not use the report feature from the original Zangle menu. This will generate the seating chart you had prior to the changeover. Instead, use the printer button that is in the top right hand corner when you are viewing your seating chart.
- To print gradebook reports, you will need to use the menu that is on the top of the screen when you are in the gradebook, or attendance sections.
- There is help documentation available. Just click on the Help button.
- Don't forget to check graded. It is so easy to forget to check the graded box for assignments. A quick way to make sure all of your assignments are being counted is to look at the spreadsheet view. A Green not means graded a red means not graded.

DID YOU KNOW?

When generating gradebook reports, you can save your settings for future use.

This is very convenient if you frequently print a report but always need to change the settings.
